Rocky Mountaineer offers luxury train journeys that showcase some of the most spectacular scenery North America has to offer. Rocky Mountaineer offers four rail routes: three in Western Canada that connect Vancouver to the Canadian Rocky Mountain towns of Banff, Lake Louise and Jasper; and a fourth route that travels between Denver, Colorado and Moab, Utah in the Southwest United States. It is a mustdo travel experience that offers unparalleled journeys in its spacious glass-dome train coaches, thanks to the incredible scenery, delicious cuisine, friendly service, and social atmosphere.

- Rocky Mountaineer travels only during the day, so guests don't miss a moment of the ever-changing landscapes.
- Rocky Mountaineer is an all glass-dome fleet, featuring two levels of service: GoldLeaf Service and SilverLeaf Service. SilverLeaf Plus is also available as an add-on on our US route.
- The meals are prepared using locally-sourced products • inspired by the regions the train travels through. Meals are served in the lower-level dining room in GoldLeaf Service, and are served at the seat in SilverLeaf Service.
- The trains run from mid-April to mid to late-October.
- Rocky Mountaineer works with local hotel partners and . tour operators to curate custom packages that feature extended stays in the destinations, so quests can experience even more of the regions.
